# WHO ARE WE

Extinction Rebellion (XR) is a global nonpartisan and non-violent network, born in 2018 out of the acute need to bring forth the true sense of urgency around the climate crisis. Using Non-Violent Direct Action (NVDA) to persuade governments to act justly on the Climate and Ecological Emergency, Extinction Rebellion has three core demands that have been incorporated and pursued by over 1,200 groups across the world.

## OUR DEMANDS

### 1. TELL THE TRUTH

Governments must tell the truth by declaring a climate and ecological emergency, working with other institutions to communicate the urgency for change.

### 2. ACT NOW

Governments must act now to halt biodiversity loss and reduce greenhouse gas emissions to net zero by 2025.

### 2. GO BEYOND POLITICS

Governments must create and be led by the decisions of a Citizens' Assembly on climate and ecological justice.



**Global Support\*** exists to support the global Extinction Rebellion movement through trainings, resources, media communications, tech infrastructure, and direct funding to local, regional and national XR groups. In alignment with the decentralized character of our movement, Global Support's objective is not to be a global governance body, but to offer support to XR groups across the world based on their own local needs and strategies.

**Everything that we do is shaped by our Principles and Values.**

\*Global Support was initially called the XR International Support Team. It's name was changed in early 2020 to reflect its global function.

## 6. WE WELCOME EVERYONE AND EVERY PART OF EVERYONE

Working actively to create safer and more accessible spaces.

## 7. WE ACTIVELY MITIGATE FOR POWER

Breaking down hierarchies of power for more equitable participation.

## 8. WE AVOID BLAMING AND SHAMING

We live in a toxic system, but no one individual is to blame.

## 9. WE ARE A NONVIOLENT NETWORK

Using nonviolent strategy and tactics as the most effective way to bring about change.

## 10. WE ARE BASED ON AUTONOMY AND DECENTRALISATION

We collectively create the structures we need to challenge power.

# REFLECTIONS ON 2020

Many XR groups came together at the start of 2020 with active hope and excitement about the year ahead - plans for Non-Violent Direct actions and regenerative community practices were abound, strategic plans to put pressure on governmental bodies were being discussed and the learning edges of collaborative ways of working were outlined. In the early months of 2020 the COVID-19 virus became a pandemic that swept across the globe, affecting us all and highlighting the devastating realities and fragilities of the present system. Our plans for outdoor action and mass demonstrations were forcibly cancelled, much of our interaction became digital and prospects for funding support were severely inhibited. In the deep recognition that this shifted the needs of activist groups all over the globe, a COVID 19 project team was formed to create a cohesive response. Movement wide open calls were hosted to listen to the needs on the ground and weekly internal calls were set up for all Global Support working groups to share information and find actionable synergies to support local groups. A harvesting process resulted in a COVID-19 Toolkit which responded to local groups needs for resources on community care and health practices, upskilling & adapted support. We mourn the gaps of the digital divide - of the rebels we were unable to reach. We celebrate the steps we have taken together to diversify our tactics and take advantage of the new forms of connection.

**Throughout 2020 we found new ways to come together to act, change, tell the truth, listen, grieve, meditate, share, learn, adapt and continue to rebel and work towards a world that is fit for the future generations of all living beings to thrive in.**

XR continues to transform and enliven the global conversation around the climate and ecological emergency; to challenge the boundaries of the possible. Our worldwide protests have targeted governments, ministries, lobbyists, and destructive companies (and no, we will not be fooled by their greenwashing). More and more people are taking responsibility in their own hands, finding ways to divest and dismantle 'business-as-usual'.

# OUR 2020 HIGHLIGHTS

In our last annual report, Global Support comprised 85 people tackling 3 areas of activity (Operations, Network and Event Mobilization). Since then, and despite Covid, we have grown to over **180 people**, working in focused teams to tackle the movement's increasing needs for resources on facilitation, trainings, media & tech communications platforms and funding.

**System support**  
takes care of **systemic needs** such as processes, policies & guidelines, translations, tech services and funding

**Community & Skills Building**  
welcomes, engages and upskills the community within our XR DNA for **empowered activism**

**Mobilization & Strategy Support**  
strives for the **expansion of our reach**, through partnerships, external communications and events, to form **bridges with local groups** to collect feedback and to assist their pursuit of XR demands

We have learned how online coordination can make us reach even further. We have learnt to be more inclusive of regions most affected by the CEE, beyond the rich Global North communities where the global rebellion started. More thinking heads, more collective wisdom, more creative and agile new forms of protest have emerged, such as digital rebellion, and money rebellion. This pandemic may seem like a time for "less action", but this is far from the truth. Our rebels have been upskilling themselves because this is a marathon and we are here for the long run.

## OUR SKILLS

**Global Support** facilitates the flow of information and learnings across the global XR movement through **online workshops, trainings, skill shares and resources**, and by providing **secure non-commercial digital tools and platforms**. Throughout 2020, we established networks of support with local groups - specifically inviting feedback and tending to the realities of activism during a global pandemic. We created and hosted hundreds of online gatherings using experimental, innovative & inclusive formats, across multiple languages and timezones. These included basic movement "DNA" trainings, interactive Non-violent communication (NVC) trainings (supported by certified NVC trainer based in Nairobi), Non-Violent Direct Action (NVDA) workshops and other trainings in Self-Organizing Systems, Regenerative cultures and participatory democracies (through Peoples Assembly facilitator trainings). Our Trainings team worked alongside experts and the Regenerative Cultures working group on such initiatives as Decolonization Co-learning circles, Campfire Calls for community dialogue and practice, Empathy Cafes to practice deep listening and coaching calls to support collective movement upskilling in facilitation methods that account for how white supremacy culture and patriarchy affect our capacity to engage collaboratively.

The pandemic created many tough challenges in 2020, but we have pulled through, built resilience, and learnt a lot. While navigating the turbulent adaptation to a postcorona world, the XR global movement still managed to grow.

# OUR 2020 HIGHLIGHTS

By facilitating **global spaces for knowledge exchange**, providing **open calls and coaching**, we supported the movement with collective learnings that could be adapted to their own local challenges. In 2020, we also offered support to local groups through a toolkit and training developed by the Participative Democracies working group on People's Assemblies (PA's) - enabling people of all backgrounds to seek effective community-led solutions to the climate crisis, elaborate proposals and engage with local authorities to leverage for change. During the last year we hosted 5 rounds of global PA's - the last PATHON for COP26 collected global recommendations to be sent to the United Nations. Our trainings, workshops and learning circles were also shared with partners outside of XR - building bridges with NGO's, other climate and social justice movements through engaging in global communities of practice and promoting knowledge about how to identify, create and maintain partnerships that strengthen our impact.

## OUR REACH

In 2020, our fundraising efforts raised over £60 thousand from major donors, in spite of the extremely challenging environment in which foundations and wealthy individuals were refocusing their limited resources on Covid relief efforts. Despite the pressure on supporter's incomes and livelihoods, we were also able to maintain the level of public giving via crowdfunding campaigns at around £60 thousand per quarter, with revenue of £250 thousand for the year. Our rebel partners in XR Germany, XR Netherlands and XR Belgium, in spite of their own revenue pressures, generously established revenue-sharing agreements with us and have been contributing to a fairly steady inflow of grant income.

Our **Regional Liaisons** team assisted in verification of grant applications to local groups, facilitating the dispersal of £138 thousand in grant funds in 2020. Working closely with national groups to disseminate our assistance, and to gather feedback information to Global Support, the Regional Liaison team was expanded to meet needs of the growing XR global network. Significant work has also been done, working with the Media team, to establish process for registering new XR groups on our global map, providing a simple and visual way for new rebels to identify and get in touch with local groups.



# OUR 2020 HIGHLIGHTS

The **Media & Messaging** Team has amplified the movement's wide range of voices from around the world via a wider range of platforms. Our newsletters bring stories and actions from the movement's many global branches, and our XR Global website, full of helpful resources, consistently produces educational and thought-provoking content about the Climate and Ecological Emergency. Search Engine Optimization (SEO) efforts last year resulted in substantial increase in visits. We have also attracted visitors to our global social media accounts: Instagram, Twitter, Facebook, and Youtube, and given their popularity, a Reactive team was created to take care of all the new incoming messages and feedback from rebels and non-rebels alike.

New videos and other media resources were produced. In collaboration with our Tech team a new global content sharing source was created, the XR Global Media Library, which aims to empower the participation of thousands in the global rebellion. Global Support's Tech team worked throughout 2020 to provide, maintain and secure the many community-run services on which Extinction Rebellion depends. We currently offer several tech tools, such as chat platform (over 800 groups worldwide), email campaign manager, webmail, survey platform, the global website, end-to-end-encrypted document storage (cloud to host over 700GB of data) and more, all of which are run on hydro-electric and solar renewable energy.

To meet the growing needs of rebels, **Tech** continued to review newly emerging and/or maturing tools of potential utility to the cause. One of the needs identified was a platform to replace Zoom, which is owned by a company found to be at direct odds with front-line activism. To this end, BigBlueButton, a web-conferencing solution, was deployed in early 2020 and has now become a critical part of the XR's day-to-day operational toolkit.

Platform accessibility in regions with poor internet connectivity was also identified as a critical issue, one ever-more prevalent where videoconferencing is concerned. Mumble was deployed to fill this critical lack with a voice-and-text only secure platform for high quality and free calls on very low-end Internet connections. We also identified a need to further protect the security of rebels, reducing the movement's dependence on Google, especially when it concerns storing sensitive content of XR groups, such as action plans and contact lists. To address this, Cryptpad - a wholly encrypted alternative to Google Docs - was trialed by Tech for the movement and has since seen exponential growth in use.

From the core services mentioned above it is estimated the platform membership of infrastructure deployed by Tech numbers between **170,000 to 180,000 rebels worldwide**.





# OUR FINANCIALS

**Global Support** has a contracted relationship with legal entities that provide us with financial services. In early 2020, UK-based Compassionate Revolution Limited provided financial services on our behalf alongside UK-based Climate 2025 Ltd. We phased out the use of Compassionate Revolution in March, to rely on Climate 2025 Ltd. for UK financial services. In July, Global Support opened a Euro account with All For Climate, a Belgian company.

Compassionate Revolution Limited is a company limited by shares and is a wholly owned subsidiary of Climate Emergency Action Ltd which was established as a not-for-profit company limited by guarantee. Climate 2025 Ltd is a not-for-profit company limited by guarantee. Both are incorporated in England. AllForClimate ASBL is a Belgian non-profit operating as a fiscal host, supporting collectives working on climate and social justice, using the platform OpenCollective.

**None of the above entities make decisions on how the funds raised by, or on behalf of, Extinction Rebellion are used.**

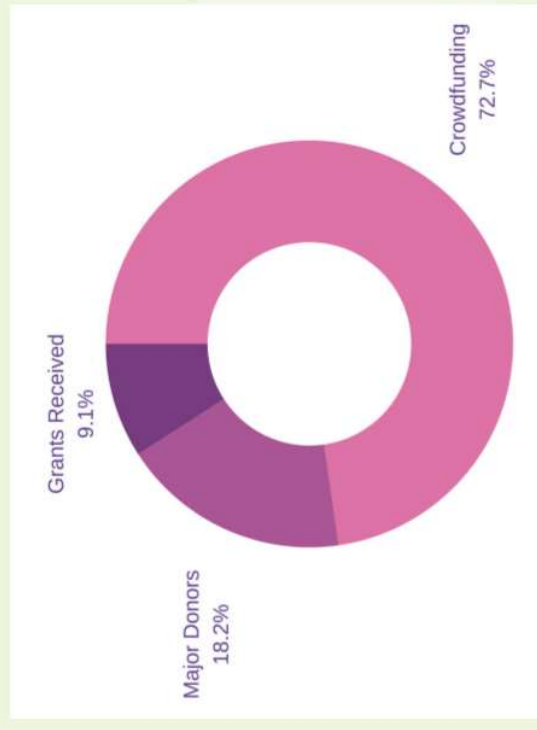


## OUR INCOME

Money is received from crowdfunding, grants from established Global North XR groups, NGOs, foundations and individuals. XR Global Support does not accept funds from polluters, arms traffickers or climate deniers. We accept that we are all victims and culprits of the fossil fuel & extractivist systems that are precipitating our climate and ecological emergency. If you are willing to take the steps to change, we will work with you.

In 2020 we had over £325 thousand of net revenues, and most of our funds came from crowdfunding via our global website. Major donations fell sharply from 2019 due to the impact of Covid. Establishment of funding support agreements from XR national groups in Belgium, Germany and the Netherlands started to help offset this shortfall in the latter part of the year.

## GLOBAL SUPPORT REVENUES 2020



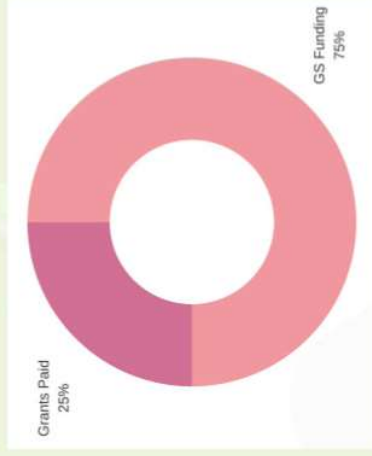
# OUR FINANCIALS

## OUR EXPENSES

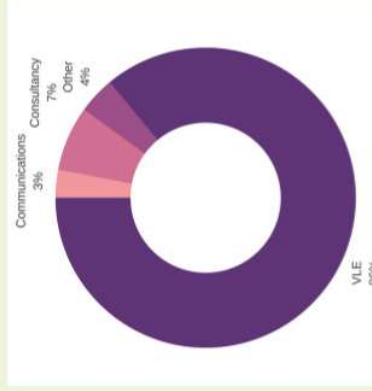
Global Support works through a number of teams each responsible for different areas. Each team has a budget holder who, working with others in the team, prepares budgets and handles requests for payments. Budgetary decisions are made by Global Support coordinators quarterly. Global Support's financial policy document can be viewed by emailing: XR-International@protonmail.com.

In 2020, through our communications expenses, we paid for servers and other technology equipment charges, in addition to programs for supporting connectivity costs for volunteers in the Global South. Consultancy was largely spent on facilitation of processes and skills needed across the global XR movement, plus accountancy charges. As "Others" we accounted for various minor grant programs and transaction costs, and during the pandemic, our needs for materials and travel expenses were much reduced due. Lastly, we accounted for Volunteer Living Expenses (VLE) paid to rebels whose essential contributions to Global Support would not be possible without helping provide for their financial needs.

### GLOBAL SUPPORT FUNDING 2020



*GS Funding supports the Tech, Media, Trainings, and other offerings described in this document. Our payments for Volunteer Living Expenses (VLE) provide the minimum funds needed to help rebel volunteers to dedicate themselves to serving the global movement. Consultancy spending was focused on conflict resolution services to help the global movement.*

## OUR GRANTS

Global Support has developed a grant giving process which mitigates for power inequalities while promoting the self organising and decentralised nature of our movement.

Global Support facilitates financial support for Extinction Rebellion groups internationally through grant awards focused on the needs of the movement and the strategic goals of the decentralised groups. All applicants must follow the Extinction Rebellion Principles and Values and are subject to a verification and due diligence process facilitated by our Regional Liaisons team.

In 2020 Global Support gave £138,124 in grants, bringing the total provided to the movement so far to £465,312. Most of the funds were disbursed in the first quarter of the year using funds raised from major donors in 2019. The scarcity of major donations in 2020 hampered our ability to undertake further large scale grant rounds last year. Instead we focused on Covid relief, and tailored grants to new groups in the Global South.

*The dominance of grants to Europe reflects the fact that at the time the bulk of the grants were made, most international XR groups were in Europe. Recent efforts have focused on directing grants to Global South*

Funds were provided to both local and national XR groups, and were spent on mobilization, actions, awareness campaigns, training and materials, internet connectivity, and consultants with expertise in the medical area for covid efforts, regenerative cultures and non-violence trainers, as well as finance advisors. Through local groups, the Extinction Rebellion movement has made significant progress in raising awareness or telling the truth to governments and our immediate communities about the urgency of climate change.

# OUR FINANCIALS

## FEEDBACK FROM LOCAL GROUPS & DONORS

**Global Support is here to serve the movement.** We are always learning how to improve and, in the spirit of Extinction Rebellion, learning together. Here is a random selection of **feedback** from donors and local groups that Global Support has supported.

**XR Rwanda** said "We were able to reach out to at least 15 families with our communities and had sessions with them on waste management. Members have been able to actively and productively participate in online meetings on time and were able to follow-up"

**XR NL** finance circle (Netherlands) said "Helping new local groups to start up, It is positive to find that we are not alone".

**XR Gambia** provided Covid-19 protection materials, organized more talks and training online with higher attendance and made strategic partnerships with other local environmental organizations. They said they achieved their objective out of the grant, community outreaches that otherwise would not have been possible.

**Donor** "I hope that I can be a small part of you making a great impact that will help our world!!"

**XRPhilly** (USA Philadelphia) "Thank you , Monies were needed to pay for office space so we could conduct four training sessions: HFE talk, NVDA Training and NVDA- Train the Trainers and a presentation by Lisa Fithian- Escalating Resistance. During this period we were just starting to generate interest from people in the surrounding Philadelphia area, and we wanted to capitalize on a unique opportunity- two excellent trainers from XRNYC and Lisa Fithian were in town and offered to train us and anyone else we invited."

**Donor** "Very impressed with all the online events and trainings on offer. Much appreciated in this time of lockdown."

**XR Whangārei** (New Zealand) used the grant to fund a 'radical action library' and allow the sharing of tools and information between action members and regional groups when needed immediately. It also allowed them to continue to educate the public, alerting to gain new supporters and regular contributors.

**XR Aotearoa** (New Zealand) "We were able to achieve more success, support other rebels, and bring our own local group closer together. COVID 19 did have a negative effect on us regionally and nationally, but we are hoping in Aotearoa/NZ that this effect is short lived."

**Donor** "Cry! Because the world governments are killing you. Try! to save our children. But don't Fly. It's the quick way to die."

**XR Slovakia** said the grant enabled them "to mount a major event (a march across the Commonwealth Ave bridge, the holding of the bridge for some period of time with a die-in, and a rally with speakers and entertainment afterwards) on the knowledge we would receive the funding. We were also able to set up an Action Network fundraiser page, and plan and execute many more events"

**Donor** "As a young professional living abroad I'd be putting myself at risk if I took part in the demonstrations. I therefore donate £50 to help you drum up support. May it help us and the planet. Give them hell. Godspeed, XR"

**Donor** "I truly appreciate the dedicated work and disobedience actions which is about the only thing that seems to get the attention of the people in charge. Please keep up your work, we love you out here and around the world. I'm so happy to be able to send a donation."

**XR ACT** (Australia) said the first grant round enabled them to set up the necessary structures and processes to generate further funds, and to build the movement. The second grant round arrived just as the global pandemic was commencing, impacting on our ability to execute our plans. In the second round, they planned for specific projects in the areas of Regenerative Culture, skills and capabilities of Coordinators, and to improve our fundraising capability. The Regenerative Culture project was 75% completed (the remaining portion unable to be finalized due to Covid restrictions). The upgrading of skills and capabilities of Coordinators has been progressing with the assistance of a consultant (services provided pro bono), and it is nearing finalization. Improving our fundraising capability has not been as successful though we have improved our financial controls and procedures, and have increased the number of regular contributors, but only by a small amount. Lack of availability of IT expertise has been an issue with this project. Not everything was accomplished as well due to the grant only being 75% of the ask.

# OUR 2021 STRATEGY

Our Global Support **vision** for the future is to work towards a world that is fit for the next 7 generations to live in: where there are mechanisms for truth to flow freely, where we thrive within the means of the planet, and where decisions are made collectively through participative democracies.

Inspired by these visions of a new world, Global Support is here with the **purpose** of interconnecting a diverse global network of rebels and creating means of practice for local groups to achieve the XR demands. Our accessible trainings and resources, secure and open-source tech and media platforms empower rebels to connect, to learn and to act. Embedded in our Principles and Values, we catalyze the growth and development of groups and regenerative community cultures.

Through our reflections of 2020, it became clear that our Strategy needed to reflect an active relationship with change:

In the next 12 months we aim to focus our delivery with 3 main elements in mind: **sustainable & compatible support** to a **connected rebellion**, empowered by **global learnings**.

**Sustainable & Compatible Support** means an ever fine-tuning of our support based on what is most needed by the movement, while remaining grounded in the capacity and scope of our delivery. At its core this is about empowering our rebel community through skill sharing that is adapted to accessibility needs in the form of (translated) information & experience sharing, trainings and co-learning spaces, in addition to funding assistance and self-sustaining tactics and support. While we give relational support in adapting materials to local contexts such as regional & cultural elements, we aim to continuously bring more global perspective in our adaptations to enrich the global movement with diversity and creativity.

A **Connected Rebellion** is a rebellion that is able to connect and align on a shared vision, and we provide a safe environment for its growth, through our reliable and secure online platforms, which help maintain cohesion and solidarity in the global community. We continue to expand our community owned & maintained platforms to provide more secure non-commercial options for communication, collaborative work, and resource exchange.

**Global Learnings** allow us to **build our expertise** and access our collective intelligence, because our diversity is our strength. Global Support is uniquely positioned to facilitate learning processes that can be supportive of different parts of the rebellion, from national and local groups, to communities, and individuals. In our intersectional nodes of collaborations we explore the different stages of feedback cycles to expand our abilities of reflecting, learning, sharing and evolving.
