

29 Ways to Say No!

1. Put up anti-racist stickers.
2. Talk to your friends & get them involved.
3. Stamp out racist graffiti. Cover up swastikas & white power slogans with anti-Nazi messages.
4. Know your local Nazis--find out all you can: who they are, who they know, where & when they hang out, what they do.
5. Expose and work against racists who are organizing people or running for office in your state or city.
6. Make your own anti-racist stickers & flyers & put them up. (Use the graphics included throughout this kit.)
7. Talk to people where you hang out: stores, clubs, schools, parks.
8. Speak your mind about things you hear: racist, sexist & anti-gay jokes, songs, & namecalling.
9. Distribute John Brown's newspapers & other literature.
10. Write articles for a school or neighborhood newspaper--or start your own anti-Nazi newspaper or zine! (Feel free to reprint our articles and graphics.)
11. Speak out against racist, sexist & anti-gay TV shows, movies, school textbooks, advertisements.
12. Learn about Black Liberation, Women's Liberation, Gay Liberation, & the struggles of Native Americans in your area. There are good books, magazines & videos you can check out.
13. Speak out against racist moves to kick out or discriminate against people of color, incl. Mexicans & Central Americans.
14. Join and support groups & projects against racism, against apartheid, against nuclear arms, against U.S. intervention in Central America or the Middle East.

15. Have a John Brown video, speaker or film presentation at your house, school, club, church.
16. Talk back to the media--call & write newspapers, radio and TV stations.
17. Call up talk shows.
18. Talk to bands. They can write songs, they can speak out onstage, & they can travel, so they can check out what's going on in different cities.
19. Support anti-racist, anti-sexist bands, zines & artists.
20. Boycott clubs that tolerate racism.
21. If you see or hear racist bands, records, or tapes, complain to the club or the store. Let us know too.
22. Keep your eye out for racist leaflets & magazines. If you can, send them to us & let us know where you found them.
23. Join & support groups & projects for human rights, for peace, for a healthy environment.
24. Speak out against laws that require use of English only.
25. Defend human rights--tell people what you think when unfair shit goes down.
26. Tell the neighborhood what you think with flyers, posters, art & spraypaint.
